

Office Tarmac Car Park - Morley Case Study





The Brief

We were asked to tarmac a car park for a building that was being transformed into offices, the customer wanted a cost effective and time efficient way to transform the car park with a new lease a life and opted for tarmac and for extra kerb appeal asked to install resin footpaths.

To install a new tarmac driveway with full groundworks, we'd install 100-150mm quality granular hardcore base to make sure the strength was there to support the number of vehicle traffic that will be using the car park, the next stage would be to install a 50-80mm binder course before finally installing a 20-40mm surface wearing course.

As in this case the resin being installed was for footfall traffic only therefore a type 3 hardcore would be installed followed by a tarmac binder base of 50-80mm before finally installing a 15mm-18mm resin bound surface.




























5 Step Processs
